Consensus Statements

Consensus Statement 1: The WG-SFP recommends that only one workshop report serve as a Flagship Initiative guiding document at a time. If multiple workshops occur, then those teams should work together to create a single workshop report. A higher-level group, similar to the current IODP Forum, might also be needed to set direction in this area or resolve conflicts.

Consensus Statement 2: WG-SFP recommends opening workshop reports to feedback from the broad community. Flagship Initiative workshop reports would be submitted to a central science support office that would (1) confirm that the report meets the requirements and (2) post the report online for additional community feedback. The Flagship Initiative workshop conveners would then revise the report as needed.

Consensus Statement 3: The WG-SFP endorses establishing an entity with a similar function as the current EPSP to carry out site-by-site reviews of proposed or scheduled expeditions from the point-of-view of safety and environmental protection.

Consensus Statement 4: The WG-SFP recommends that Flagship Initiative workshop reports include a plan for sharing data across expeditions.
